What is Residential Repair?

- It is open to renters and homeowners, age 60 and older.
- Provides household assistance with chores that do not require the skills of a licensed craftsman.
- While the services are open to *all seniors*, priority is given to low income minority elderly.



TYPICAL SERVICES PROVIDED

- ▶ **Plumbing:** replace washers or faucets in kitchen sinks
- ▶ **Electrical:** repair or rewire lamps, replace light switches, etc.
- ▶ **Carpentry:** install grab bars or safety rails for tubs and toilets
- ▶ **Weatherization:** caulking and weather-stripping of windows and doors
- ▶ **Exterior:** minor patching of walk ways.
- ▶ **Crime Prevention:** install door locks, window locks, etc.
- ▶ **Miscellaneous:** replace broken window panes; installation or removal of storm windows and screens, *small* air conditioners.



Recipients of service under CSE, **Residential Repair**, shall be given the opportunity to make a voluntary and anonymous contribution. All contributions are used to expand the program.

Service will not be denied based on a senior's inability to make a voluntary contribution.

Program participants agree to pay for any and all materials used to complete their repair.
